

# VELA POOL

**This season we are pleased to advise we are launching a new concept on how we run the pool memberships.**

We have split the use into 2 areas. The first is **Lane Swimming**; where we invite those interested to purchase a membership for the season and join the club. This is for adults and youth who are keen to lane swim. The other is **Community Use** and this is for those who wish to use the pool inside of the managed hours. There is no membership for community use this year, instead we have 2 concession card options. We also have a one-off swim option as well.

## TERM TIMES

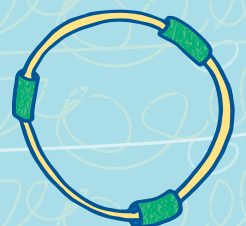
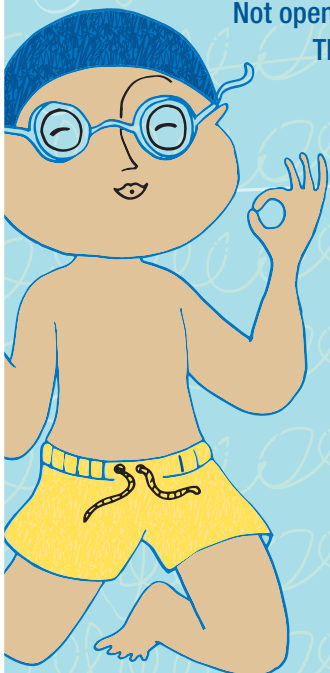

# PASS HOLDER CONDITIONS

<h2>Adult Lane Swimming</h2>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Swim between 'lane swimming' hours indicated on the timetable</li> <li>• Swimming outside of facility manager hours, Lane Swimmers need to swim with another lane 'Adult Lane Swimming' pass holder. There must <b>always be two</b> 'Adult Lane Swimming' pass holders in the pool at once during these outside hours</li> <li>• Take covers off with another adult if arrive first in the day and put covers on if last in the day (how this is to be done will be explained during health and safety induction)</li> <li>• Take Robo-Vac out of pool on arrival if you are the first swimmers of the day (will be explained during health and safety induction)</li> <li>• Wear a swim cap. Swim caps are available to buy (\$12) form the pool office during community use times</li> <li>• If bringing a 'Youth Lane Swimming' pass holder to swim as well, remember you are responsible and the lifeguard for them. A youth lane pass holder does not count as an adult — <i>Youth lane swimmers must be approved by the school with evidence that they are or have been a competent squad swimmer</i></li> <li>• There will be a lane available for lane swimming</li> <li>• Lane pass swimmers to follow the pool rules at all times</li> <li>• Bring a cellphone when swimming outside of facility manager hours</li> <li>• Ensure gate is locked on your exit outside of facility manager hours</li> <li>• 'Adult Lane Swimming' pass holders need to be fully inducted by authorised staff / adult</li> <li>• Adult Lane Swimming pass holders will be issued with an entry swipe tag.</li> </ul>
<h2>Youth Lane Swimming</h2>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Swim between 'lane swimming' hours indicated on the timetable</li> <li>• Outside of pool supervisor attendance hours, need to swim with two other 'Adult Lane Swimming' pass holders</li> <li>• During facility manager hours swim under the same rules as a concession pass holder without paying concession prices</li> <li>• Wear a swim cap. Swim caps are available to buy (\$12)</li> <li>• A lane will be available for lane swimming during the timetabled swim hours</li> <li>• Lane pass swimmers to follow the pool rules at all times</li> <li>• Outside of pool supervisor attendance hours, 'Youth Lane Swimming' pass holders must only use the pool for length swimming and not 'free play swim'</li> <li>• 'Youth Lane Swimming' pass holders will be issued with a laminated card.</li> </ul>
<h2>Community Use</h2>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can only swim during 'Community Use' hours indicated on timetable</li> <li>• Can buy a bulk community use card or pay each time</li> <li>• 'Community Use' swimmers to read and follow the pool rules at all times</li> <li>• Wear a swim cap. Swim caps are available to rent (\$1) or buy (\$12)</li> <li>• 'Community Use' swimmers need to stop at small office gate to sign and be checked in by facility manager, at every swim</li> <li>• Children under 18 years of age <b>can not</b> swim without a paying, supervising adult</li> <li>• Children are the responsibility of the supervising adult entering with the child.</li> </ul>

**Note:** The pool must only be used for Lane Swimming when unmanaged from 7am-1pm daily. Splashing around and having fun is only after 1pm daily when there are pool staff on site, but after 1pm there will be a designated lane available for those who want to lane swim.
